 REGISTRATION FEES: **Before April 15<sup>th</sup>** - \$65 for one child, \$110 for two children; \$155 for three or more children  
**April 15<sup>th</sup> and after** - \$85 per child with no maximum

## CRESTWOOD CRUISERS SWIM TEAM -2010 PARENT VOLUNTEER SIGN-UP

Every swim meet requires more than *TWENTY* adult volunteers. To ensure the smooth running of the team, each family is required to fulfill a minimum (2) volunteer positions for the first swimmer and (1) additional position for each additional swimmer. Below is a brief description of each position. Please indicate your first and second choice of positions on the registration form. While no guarantees can be given, every effort will be made to meet your request. You will be *ASSIGNED* two dates. If you are unable to volunteer on your assigned day, it will be *YOUR* responsibility to find your own replacement. *Refusal to fulfill your volunteer obligations may result in your registration being refused next year.*

### **VOLUNTEER DUTIES:**

**Timer:** Responsible for timing each swimmer assigned to given lane during a swim meet and relaying those times to Recorder. The team provides stopwatches. Requires standing on the docks at Crestwood Lake for home meets or poolside/lakeside for away meets.

**Starter/ Referee:** Responsible for starting each heat and calling the next heat to the starting line. Requires standing on the docks at Crestwood lake (home meets only). Responsibilities will be explained prior to the meets.

**Finish Judge:** responsibilities for determining the order of the finish of the swimmers in each heat and relaying those results to the Recorder. Requires standing on the docks at Crestwood Lake for home meets or poolside/lakeside for away meets.

**Recorder:** Responsible for writing down swimmers' times from the Timers and the order of the finish received from the Finish Judge after each heat and sending those results to the scoring table. Requires standing on the docks at Crestwood lake (home meets only) Responsibilities will be explained prior to the meets.

**Scorer:** Responsible for tallying the results received from the Recorder. Instructions will be provided prior to the start of the meet.

**Marshalling / check-in:** responsible for gathering / organizing swimmers before each heat. Swimmers are to remain near the volleyball net area for the duration of the meet or risk missing their event. Each marshal is required to bring tow beach chairs to be used to lineup swimmers before their events. Apply swimmers number prior to swim meet.

**Set-up or Clean-Up:** Responsible for the set-up/ takedown the public address system, roping, scorer's table, etc. Instructions will be provided prior to the start of the meet (home meets only). Arrive early / stay late

**Meet Reminder Calls:** Responsible for calling timers, judges, etc on a timely basis prior to each meet to remind individuals of their volunteer assignment. Each volunteer for this position will make calls for approximately 2-3 meets. (Counts as one volunteer requirement) notify the meet reminder parent if you are switching your assignment.

**Refreshments Table:** responsible for selling refreshments during home meets and helping with set-up and clean-up of the refreshment table. (Please volunteer for this only once)

**Ribbon Writer:** Responsible for writing ribbons at the meets.

**Publicity:** Responsible for submitting articles on meets results weekly to local papers.

<p><b>PLEASE REMEMBER:</b> if you are unable to volunteer on your scheduled day, <b>IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO FIND YOUR OWN REPLACEMENT.</b> The team does not have a "general manager" to do so. Please mark this sheet with the dates and position volunteered for and keep for you records.</p>
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
